MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF

BOLTON by BOWLAND, GISBURN FOREST & SAWLEY PARISH COUNCIL

HELD AT BOLTON by BOWLAND VILLAGE HALL ON 17th MAY 2021 AT 7.30 P.M.

- 1. To approve to lift the Emergency Powers currently delegated to Parish Clerk under Covid regulations
- 1.1 Members **resolved** to lift the Emergency Powers delegated to Parish Clerk under Covid regulations in order that the meeting be duly convened.
- 2. Election of CHAIRMAN who will then sign Acceptance of Office of Chairman (Members are reminded that the Chairman may be annually elected for a period of no more than three years) Cllr. Hayden Fortune has completed 3 years as Chairman plus additional year due to Covid 19 and is therefore ineligible for re-election
- 2.1 Nominations for Chairman were received for Elizabeth Twist and Arnold Foster. Following a vote it was

RESOLVED that Cllr. Elizabeth Twist be elected Chairman of the Parish Council.

- 4. To welcome the new Elected Member to Parish Council for Bolton by Bowland Ward of the Parish, who will sign a Declaration of Office Form (A Declarations of Interest Form must be completed & returned to Parish Clerk within 28 days)
- 4.1 Mr. Nigel Bunyan had been duly elected as a Member of Parish Council and, having completed his Declaration of Interests form & signed Declaration of Office, he was welcomed as Member to Bolton by Bowland, Gisburn Forest & Sawley Parish Council.
- 4.2 Clerk had countersigned his Declaration of Office form & was to publish these forms on Parish Council's website in addition to submission to Ribble Valley Borough Council.

- 5.3 Following discussion it was **RESOLVED that Cllrs. Foster, Fortune, Twist & Whitwell continue to be signatories for the bank account.**
- Planning Applications to be considered by all Parish Councillors on email
- 5.4 Members noted that Planning Applications continue to be considered by all via email
- RVBC Liaison Committee Representatives (2 Representatives, meetings held at RVBC Office 7.00pm start)
- 5.5 It was **RESOLVED that Clirs. Curry & Twist be Parish Council representatives to this Committee**
- RV LALC Area Liaison Committee (2 Councillors may attend, meetings held at RVBC Office, 6.30pm start)
- 5.6 It was **RESOLVED that Clirs. Curry & Twist be Parish Council representatives to this Committee**
- Any other representatives to other bodies
- 5.7 Members were unclear about representation requirement to Bolton by Bowland Village Hall Committee; Clerk was asked to check 2019 Parish Council Minutes and the Village Hall Constitution.
- 6. To consider and approve dates and venues for Parish Council meetings in the year 2021/22
- 6.1 Members considered that venue & meeting dates should return to the previous format of first Monday in each month, except January & August, however this was to be monitored, dependent on the latest Covid situation. It was therefore

RESOLVED that the next Parish Council Meeting be held on Monday 07 June 2021.

- 7.1 Chairman, Cllr. Fortune gave a brief report, since activities for the Parish Council had been cut short due to the pandemic. He thanked the 2 election candidates and welcomed Cllr. Bunyan.
